## **DIY: Placemats with Pocket**

Today WSI brought a **creative idea** for those who like to dine in open spaces such as in the backyard or in the park. In these environments it usually sells a lot so it is very difficult to get disposable plates and cutlery to stop on the table.

Have you ever thought about using a placemat **with a pocket**? This is a very interesting solution for this occasion, because in addition to solving the problem, it still makes the table much more charming. And it doesn't take a lot of sewing knowledge to make a game like this. With this step by step below you can cut the fabrics yourself and sew, or for those who do not have a sewing machine at home, have a seamstress do it.

Choose at least 2 fabrics.

Cut 6 of each into 18.5 x 12.5 inches.


Cut 4 18 x 12 inches of batting.

Take 2 of fabric A and one of fabric B. Fold fabric B in half along the long edge with right sides out. Place the folded fabric on one of the fabric A pieces. Have the fold in the middle and the edged against the bottom of fabric A. Place the batting on the back side of the other piece of fabric A. Place right sides together and sew with a 5/8 inch seam. Leave a large gap at the bottom so that you can turn right sides out.

Trim a triangle off the corners.

Turn right side out. Use a seam ripper to pull out the corners. Top stitch around all 4 sides.
