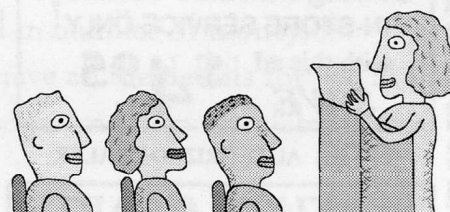
At the July Meeting, Doris Patterson will be educating the members about "quilt show judging" during the program. Those of us who plan on having quilts judged should find this a very interesting program.

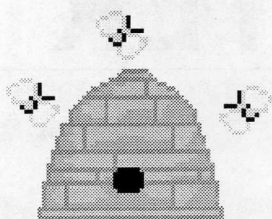
HELP NEEDED

Bee Round-Up!!!

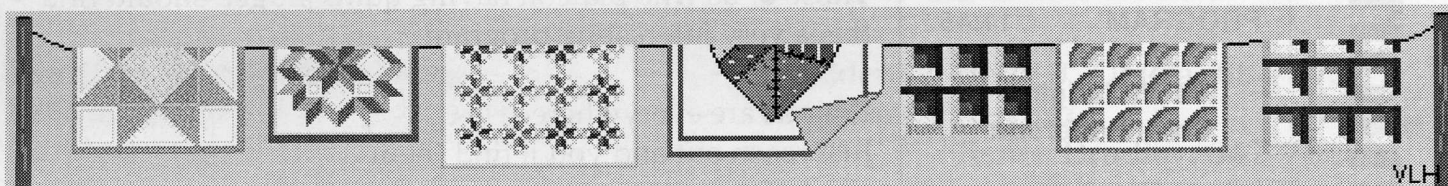
