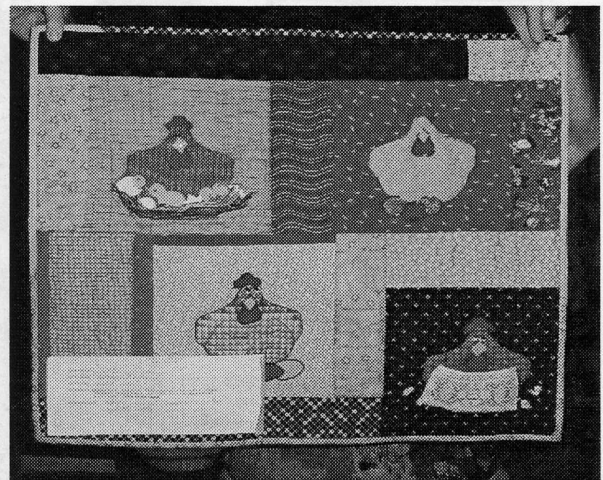
President's Letter

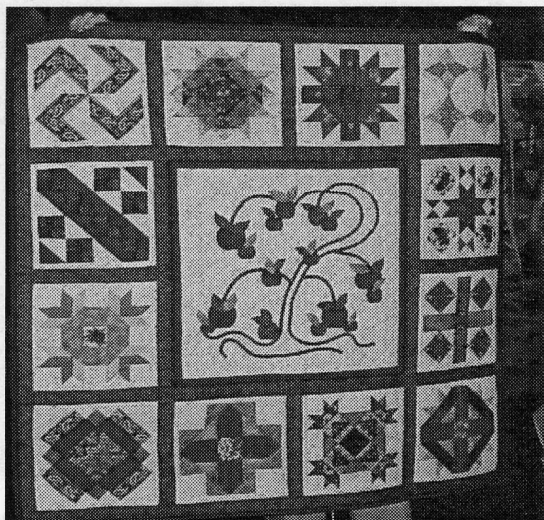

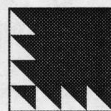
Debra Pavelka showed a lovely quilt prepared by our guild for the San Antonio Children's Shelter. They will use it for a fundraiser.

Operating Fund: \$14,667.79 Reserve Fund: \$45,897.97 Total: \$60,565.76

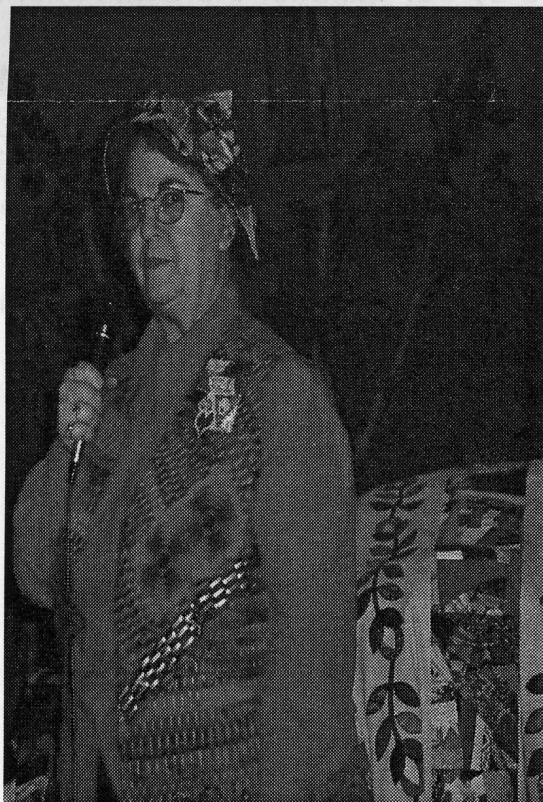

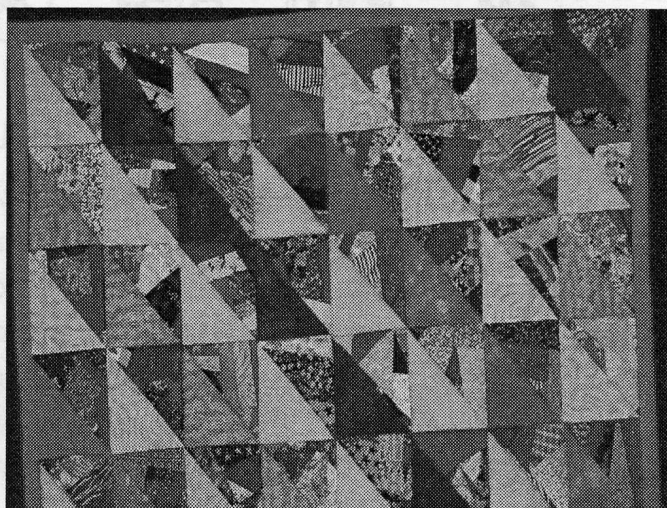
Services: Judith Miller stated that there will be a general inventory of the libraries to include books, magazines, videos and patterns. Discussion was held about mentoring new members.

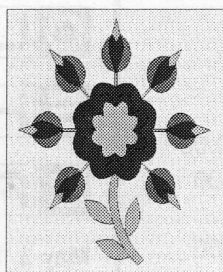
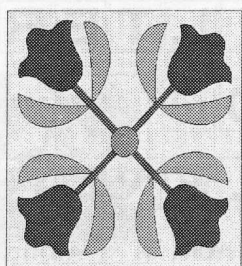

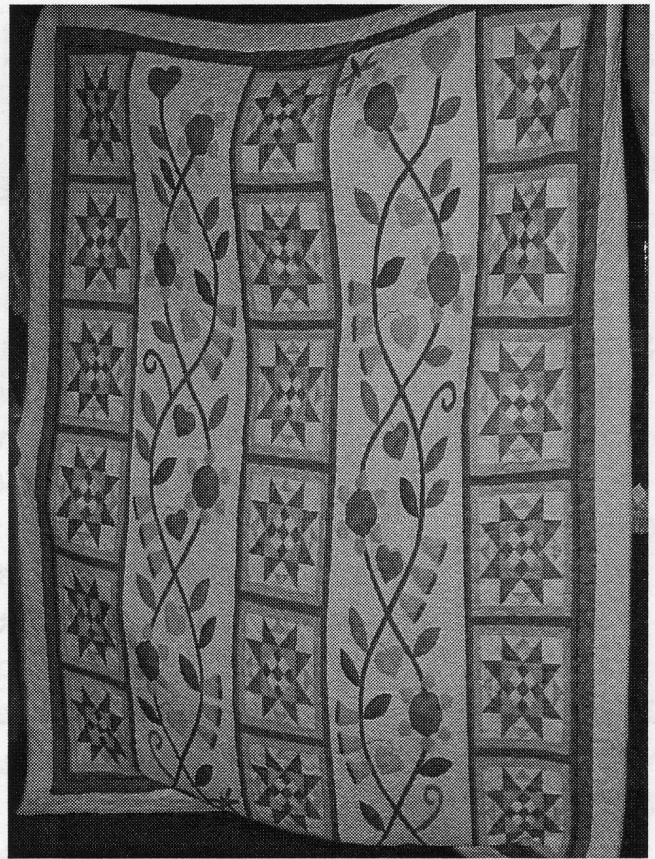

Please use solids or monotone, or small prints that say one color.

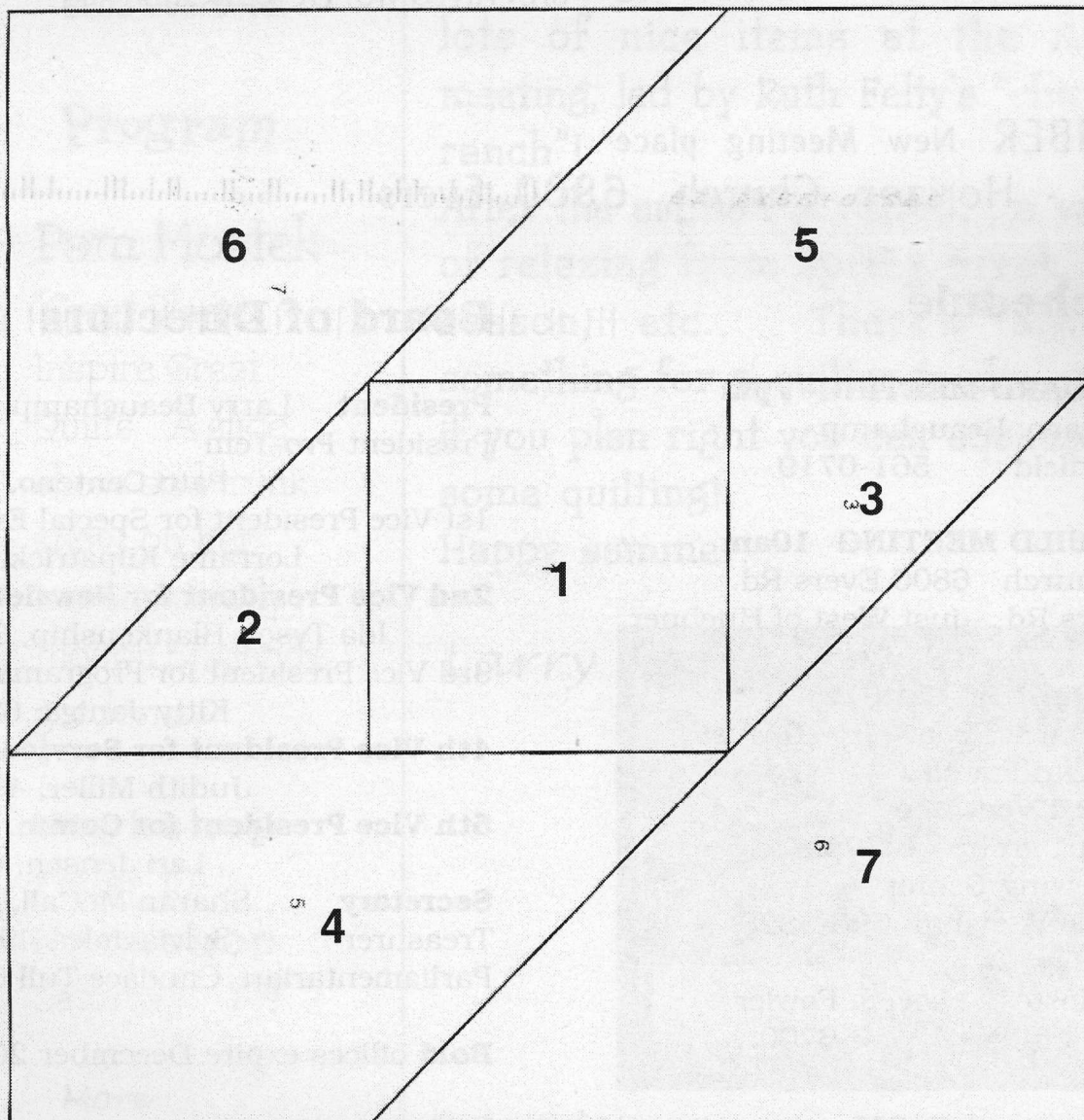


Please use all cotton, pre-washed fabrics.
