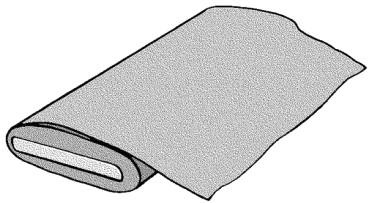

Bring your lunch, latest project and spend the afternoon sewing, sharing, or maybe just some down time after the Holidays. Will have Guild power strips, irons and big boards.

February. We are bring back Mini-demos. The mini-demo will be 20 minutes, repeated three times so you will have an opportunity to sit in on all three mini-demos. Barbara Sumlin will cover Basic Sewing Machine Maintenance, Dea Jae Shore will be demoing Machine Quilting with Templates and Jackie Randall will have a new ruler, Perfectly Pieced Pineapples.

March. Beth Helfter, evapagequilts.com, quilt designer and instructor from Massachusetts. Beth has been quilting for 20 yrs. and featured in Quilter's World, The Quilter, Quiltmaker's 100 Blocks and other publications. Member of the 2014 Quiltmaker's "Scrap Squad". Her philosophy is "Inspired designs, relaxed attitude". Friday workshop: Syncopated Ribbons. You will need your sewing machine, an overflowing scrap bin, outside the box thinking and chocolate. Friday's class will cost \$43.00. Saturday workshop: "Now You Give It A Scrap Slap." You will bring 81-3 in. squares, in class all the squares will be dumped in a pile and each student will pull squares for their block. All students will work the same block but in different value, colors, contrast, and placement. Will need a sewing machine. Saturday's class wil cost \$28.00.

April. Leslie Tucker Jenison, San Antonio, will be our teacher and lecturer. She is a designer for RJR fabrics. Has been quilting since the early 80's. Leslie is a published and award winning modern quilter. Friday workshop: Move Over, Mondrian. The class modernizes the idea of a log cabin quilt. Saturday Workshop: Random Acts of Stripping. Sew various widths and length of fabric into a quilt top.

Songwriter and electric violinist Dennis McGregor toured with Jimmy Buffett and other artists in the '70s. His unusual odd style was slow to catch on. Living in Sisters, Oregon Dennis was confronted with quilts on almost a daily basis. He began to incorporate quilts into his bright paintings and posters, first creating his own patterns, and later using actual quilts as models.

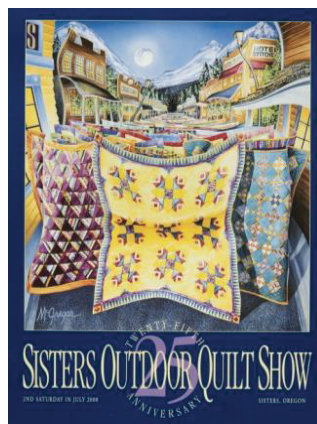
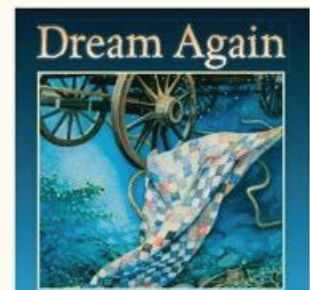
Dennis had an idea for an unusual quilt, spurred in July 2000 by the 25th anniversary of the Sisters, Oregon annual Outdoor Quilt Show. Assisted by quilter Jackie Erickson, a quilt was designed with squares and rectangles that could be enlarged from 3 inches square to 3-foot square. A group of 891 volunteers gathered on the high school football field, each holding a fabric square - all donated for the event. A crane was used to get an aerial view of the framed fabrics before, during, and after flipping them over to reveal the finished "quilt." Dennis used the photos as a guide for his poster.



Dennis has been painting the charming Sisters' Rodeo, Folk Festival, and Outdoor Quilt Show posters for years which are featured on t-shirts, mugs, and greeting cards. He also writes and illustrates children's books. *Dream Again* is about a patchwork quilt that leads an orphan girl and her horse into an exciting adventure. "The story, set in 1845, was driven by the notion that every antique quilt in every home today would have some kind of story to tell."

His painting, "Quilting Bee" was the kickstarter for his newest humorous book, *You Stole My Name*, pairing two animals such as bull-frog and spider-monkey. In "Quilting Bee" an actual bee is using a 'Stinger' sewing machine. One of Dennis' original posters is included in the background.


